

The House That Jack Built

This is my third Jelly Roll quilt.

I love traditional blocks, so I designed three different house blocks – two wide and one slim house which are staggered across the quilt.

The sashing gives the appearance of a road running between the streets.

Quickly made using a Jelly Roll but also easily created from stash – 2 1/2" strips needed.

A simple checkerboard sets off the border.

Finished size 50" x 70"



Requirements

1 x Jelly Roll (I prefer Moda for choice of co-ordinated fabrics and accuracy)

Or a selection of co-ordinating fabrics – cut (2) 2 1/2" strip x 22" for each house

A fat 1/4m of cream for sky/background

1 1/4m for sashing (blue)

1 m for border (pink)

3m backing

1 1/2m wadding 90" wide I will have Hobbs fusible wadding with me.

Rotary cutting set

Sewing machine with 1/4" foot

General sewing equipment
